Volunteer Grant Programs

Offered:	Yes
Minimum Hours:	10 Hours
Corporate donation:	\$50 every quarter an employee volunteers for 10 hours

Through HP's employee volunteer rewards program where HP provides \$50 Good Cards to every US employee who volunteers for at least 10 hours per quarter.

Good Cards are issued through HP's relationship with Network for Good and allow employees who volunteer on a regular basis to donate \$50 to their a charity of their choosing each quarter.

Volunteer Grant Submission Process: Employees should log their hours through HP's internal volunteer system which can be accessed through the company intranet. Then each quarter HP employees who logged 10 hours of volunteering will receive personalized emails with their Good Card codes. The Good Card codes can then be redeemed by the employee for a charitable donation to any nonprofit by going to <http://www1.networkforgood.org/hp>.
