Listed below are brief descriptions of the opportunities that we have available.

Yearlong Opportunities:

Everything! — You will be notified of ALL PTA Volunteer opportunities. This does not commit you to help with everything — only keeps you informed about what's going on so you can help when it fits your schedule.

Box Tops/Redemptions Helper – Help trim, sort, count box tops and labels for your grade level team. This can easily be done from home.

Communication – PTA website, Social Media, Newsletter liaisons

Community Involvement Committee-Assist this chair with ideas and suggestions on how our students can be more involved and help out those in need

Go Green Committee — help educate our students on what it means to recycle and how they can recycle many of the daily items that they use. This committee also gathers items and ships them to TerraCycle and the company upcycles these products into reusable items.

Healthy Lifestyles Committee — Help encourage RMS students and community to increase activity, eat healthy foods, assist with the running club.

Membership Committee - help with strategies to recruit members, attend events throughout the year to promote membership

Mentoring – spend 30 minutes each week having lunch, playing games, building relationships with a student

Office Helper – Assist in the front office during the lunch hour or as needed

Scholarship Committee — helps determine who our next scholarship recipients will be (winter/spring time frame)

Spirit Wear Committee - help sell spirit wear at all school, athletic and PTA related events

Sponsorship Committee — help solicit local businesses to partner with us to help support the various activities that we have planned throughout the year

Student Engagement Committee — helps plan quarterly events for our students

Event Only Opportunities:

A & A/B Honor Roll Ceremonies — help distribute awards for our honor roll students

Arts in Education/Reflections — advertise & promote this program to our students and encourage their participation (Fall)

Book Fairs – help library staff decorate, advertise and work the book fair

Concessions — help with concession sales during home athletic events and PTA events

Grade Level Dances — Assist with promoting & selling tickets prior to the event. Assist with decorating and cleaning up. Help with

concession sales. (6th Grade - 9/30, 7th Grade - 11/11, All School Dance 2/10)

Holiday Social Student Event – help coordinate this special holiday event for our students (12/13)

PAWS (Panthers Are Winning Students) Ceremonies — help set up, provide snacks and treats for students

Red Ribbon Week— assist counselors and coordinator with the weekly events (10/24-28)

Spirit Nights — help provide fresh ideas on what restaurants to attend, help advertise and promote the event (monthly)

Spring Student Event— help coordinate the spring student event **(May)**

Trunk or Treat Student Event*— help coordinate trunk or treat community event (10/28)

Valentine's Sales – assist coordinator with the sales and distribution of valentine's (2/7 - 14)

Veterans Day – help coordinate this appreciation celebration for our Veterans (11/11)

Flexible Opportunities:

Baking/Donating Goods - provide baked or purchased snacks/goods for different events and staff appreciation throughout the year

Clothes Closet - volunteer once a month to help at the clothes closet at Voigt Elementary

Library Helper – assist students with checking books in/out, shelving books and special projects as needed

Lunchtime Helper — help provide an opportunity for our students to go outside during their lunch period by volunteering your lunch hour. Students will eat lunch and then have the remaining time to enjoy activities outdoors.

Watch D.O.G.S. (Dads of Great Students) — this opportunity is for dads, grandfathers, uncles and father figures. Spend a day (or any amount of time you have available) volunteering — monitoring the school entrance and lunchroom, assisting with unloading and loading cars and buses, monitoring hallways, chaperone dances, assist in supervision at school events.
